What Are Cookies?

As is common practice with almost all professional websites, the Godolphin and Latymer School website uses cookies. Cookies are small files that are downloaded to your computer to improve your browsing experience. This page describes what information they gather, how we use it and why we sometimes need to store these cookies. We will also share how you can prevent these cookies from being stored. Please note that disabling cookies may downgrade or 'break' certain elements of the site's functionality.

How We Use Cookies

We use cookies for a variety of reasons. Cookies help the website keep track of your visits and activity to personalise information to enhance your browsing experience. They're used to store data about your needs and preferences so that a web server doesn't have to repeatedly request this information, potentially slowing download time.

Disabling Cookies

You can disable cookies by simply adjusting the settings on your browser (see the 'Help' section on your browser for how to do this). However, some of the functionality and features of this site, and many other websites that you visit, may be affected by doing so. It is recommended that you leave on all cookies if you are not sure whether you need them or not, as they may provide a service that you regularly use.

Third Party Cookies

In some special cases we also use cookies provided by trusted third parties.

This site uses Google Analytics, which is one of the most widespread and trusted analytics solutions on the web for helping us to understand how you use the site and ways that we can improve your experience. These cookies may track things such as how long you spend on the site and the pages that you visit so we can continue to produce engaging content.

Details of Cookies Used

The website uses a consent management platform (CookieYes) which maintains a live record of the cookies used on the website, grouped as necessary, functional, analytics and advertisement. For each cookie, it lists the provider, the purpose and duration. That record is updated automatically whenever the site changes and is published on the website itself.
